- Seek feedback and input from all stakeholders about what is working/what is not working with current services and systems, and what changes they would like to recommend with CFCM/CMRD; and
- Ensure all people/families successfully transition to the new Case Management Agency (CMA) with no gaps in service and receive case management support from a team of competent, knowledgeable and dedicated staff.

Weld County is our catchment area

Case Management – bid process initially and every 8 years

Case Management Agency will be providing CM for all 10 Waiver Programs

CFCM/CMRD's Impact on Envision

Envision's Board of Directors decided to not respond to the Case Management Agency RFP, meaning we will no longer be providing Case Management Services for CES, CHRP, DD Waiver, HCBS-SLS or State General Fund ProgramsFSSP, State SLS, and OBRA

> Envision will continue to provide Direct Services (Adult Residential, Family Care Giver, Day Program, Supported Employment, Summer Respite Camp) and Service Coordination for Early Intervention
